Campaign to date: \$151.2 million; Year to date: \$6.3 million

South CARES Fund - \$35,000 in aid awarded last week directly to students impacted.

Bridging the Gap Program – funds from donors to provide scholarships to students with outstanding student account balances.

12. Graduate Studies Update (JK)

Dr. Kovaleski sent chairs an email information update on options for those programs which require a GRE or MAT exam score. The option that was provided by the Graduate School in terms of accepting a student without the standardized test score does not applied to a student that does not meet the GPS requirement for admission. GRE at home test option is now available to students.
