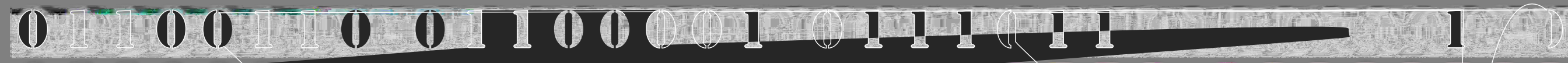

Graduate School Compliance System

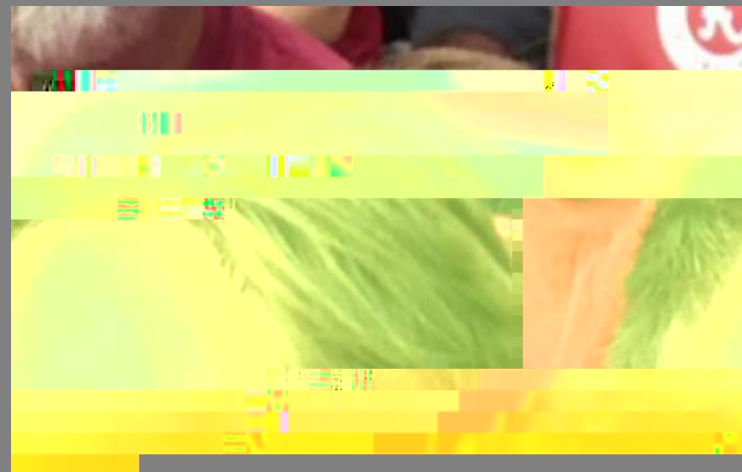

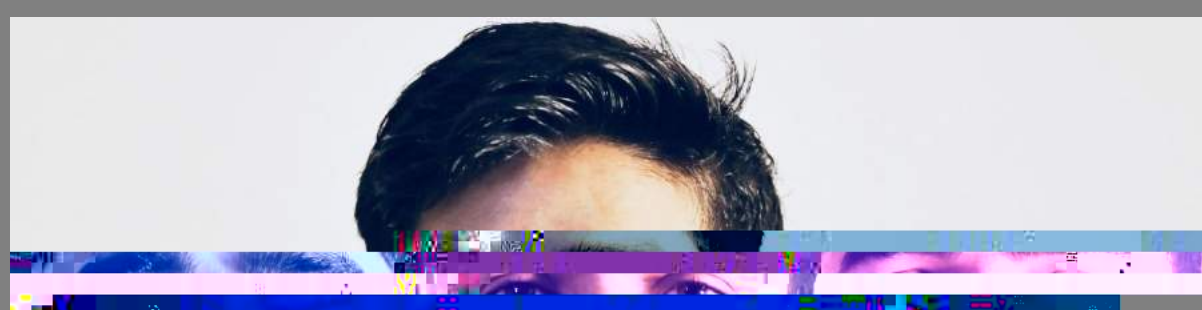
