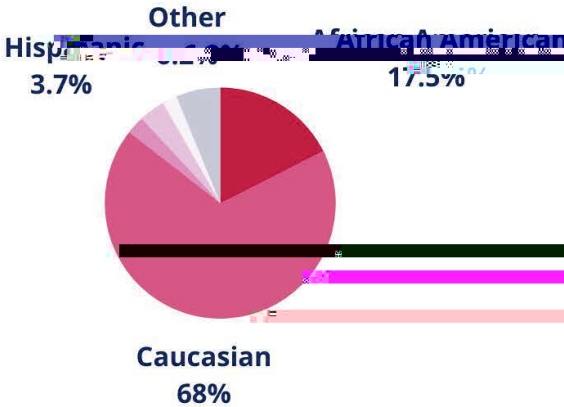


# SPRING 2021 GRADUATING STUDENTS

## Student Satisfaction
